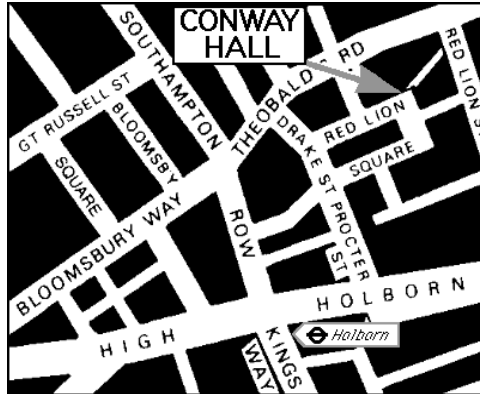
**DURING THE EXAM...**

### Underground

### Buses

The following buses pass through or near Holborn stopping just a few minutes walk to the Hall:

- from Oxford Street: 8, 25, 55; 98 (terminates in Red Lion Square)
- from Euston Station: 59, 68, 91, 188
- from Waterloo Station: 1, 59, 68, 188, 521, 243
- from Victoria: 38 (Theobalds Rd, rear side of Hall)
